Subject: REACH substance information from ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products

Following the end of the pre-registration period and in accordance with EC Regulation 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products informs you that our suppliers have pre-registered the substances produced or imported into the EU, and for which there are responsibilities arising from the application of REACH. As you know, it is not mandatory under REACH to provide pre-registration numbers and some of our suppliers have decided not to communicate these numbers.

With regard to compliance with the Regulation, ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products confirms that:

- Semi-finished products / steel products are considered as articles according to Article 3 of Regulation 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), as recognized by ECHA in the letter to Eurofer (European steel association) on 2 September 2009. http://www.eurofer.org/index.php/eng/content/download/5030/26762/file/Reply%20ECHA%20on%20EUROFER%20letter.%202%20September%202009.pdf

They are therefore **NOT** subject to registration obligations.

- The steel, which constitutes the product manufactured by ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products, does not contain substances that are intended to be released or are released during the reasonable use of the steel, as indicated in article 7 of the regulation.

Tubular Products Europe

That this steel does not contain:

- Substances above the declaration thresholds (>0.1% by weight)
- Not are subject to authorizations according to Annex XIV
- Not are included in the candidate lists for the authorization process. http://guidance.echa.europa.eu/authorisation en.htm#candidatelist)
- Not are among the substances of very high concern (SVCH-substances of very high concern)

- That the substances used in our products comply with REACH requirements and have been pre-registered within the established timeframe if applicable.
- That it has received from its supplier's express communication on REACH compliance.
- That the substances used in its products are not included in categories 1 and 2 of the CMR, according to DIRECTIVE 67/548/EEC on classification and labelling of substances.

ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products will continue to assess and monitor substances in articles to ensure compliance with the requirements of the REACH Regulation. In case of either the substance contained in our products are possible to find in concentrations higher than 0.1% was included to Annex XIV in the future, or entered on the "candidate list", ArcelorMittal Europe Tubular Products in accordance with Article 33 of REACH Regulation, shall forward information about this substance to the Customers.
